### Vision

The senior management team and all staff are committed to protecting the environment and strive to reduce the property's operational impact on the environment

Effective sustainability practices have been in place since the resort's development phase, but our goal remains to go beyond current standards and applicable environmental laws and regulations, as well as to continue exploring the latest technological innovations and scientific advances. We will continue our efforts to create awareness and transparency - for guests, partners, suppliers, colleagues and the surrounding communities.

### Goals

Through our environmental policy we will:

- reduce harmful environmental impacts such as pollution, greenhouse gas emissions and excessive resource consumption wherever possible.
- ensure we comply with all applicable environmental laws and regulations
- measure our environmental performance against our objectives and targets, making sure that we regularly review our progress
- train our staff in our environmental commitments, so that they understand the role they play in delivering our objectives and targets
- encourage our guests to support our efforts to reduce our environmental impact by reducing carbon emissions, promoting renewable energy and avoiding waste
- keep our island free of invasive non-native species, pests and exotic species in gardens and landscapes by prohibiting their import and planting and removing them in the event of accidental establishment.

To achieve our environmental goals in the next 2 years, we aim to:

- Renew our Travelife Gold accreditation for Hotels & Accommodation as well as receiving our first Green Globe Certification
- Further reduce our energy and water consumption per capita through sensible practices in production and usage to all over reduce our carbon footprint.
- Intensify and streamline our waste segregation processes and identify opportunities to reuse or recycle
- Further reduce the import/use of single-use plastic wherever possible
- Further monitor the use of potentially harmful chemicals in our operations and opt for environmentally friendly alternatives wherever possible
- Expand our employee training and guest lectures to promote environmentally friendly thinking
- Actively support local groups and schools in their environmental programs
- Treat our environment and resources in a sustainable manner at all times
- Continue to collaborate with and be part of NGOs and organisations such as Manta Trust and Olive Ridley Project to protect the local environment and provide valuable scientific data.
